

## **INVESTMENT POLICY STATEMENT (IPS) REVIEW CHECKLIST**

THIS CHECKLIST IS DESIGNED TO IDENTIFY IF CHANGES TO YOUR PROSPECT'S/CLIENT'S IPS MAY BE NEEDED.

If you answer 'YES' to any of the following questions, you should have your IPS reviewed, and, if necessary, updated. Review your current IPS at least annually. YES NO 1. Have there been any changes to the plan/portfolio objectives? 2. Have the risk, return or time horizon parameters changed? 3. Has the rebalancing protocol (if applicable) changed? 4. Has there been any change in service providers (e.g., recordkeeper)? 5. Have there been any changes to the investment selection, monitoring or replacement criteria? 6. Has there been a change to the asset class guidelines (e.g., new default investment option)? 7. Have there been any changes to the service provider evaluation criteria? 8. Have there been any changes to the service provider duties (e.g., 3(21) to 3(38) advisor)? 9. Have the procedures for controlling and accounting for investment expenses changed? 10. Have there been any significant changes to your company's structure?
